## Ministry of Labour

Department of Friendly Society Limitations of Office Holders

- No person shall without the permission in writing of the Registrar, hold both the offices of president and treasurer of the same society
- No person shall hold both the office of the secretary and treasurer
- No person shall hold the office of treasurer in more than one society.
- No person holds any other office therein shall be or act as the medical officer, dentist, optician or druggist of any society.
- No person shall hold the offices of Secretary and trustee or treasurer and trustee of same society.

## Benevolence

Priority of claim of registered Society on death or insolvency of Officer by value of his office. Any officer having custody or possession of money or property belonging to a Society, or if any execution, attachment, or other possession is issued against that officer or his property, his heirs, executors, or administrators, or assignee in insolvency, or the marshal or other person executing the process, shall on demand in writing of any person authorized by the Society, or by the committee or management thereof, to make the demand, pay the money and, deliver over the property to the committee or management in preference to any debts or claims against the estate of the officer. ## **Property and Funds**

The committee of the management of the society, or a majority of the members thereof present and entailed to vote in general meeting, may from time to time invest the funds of the Society, or any part thereof, to any amount in any of the following ways:

- In any saving bank
- In any government funds of Commonwealth territory
- In the purchase of land, and in the erection or alternation of officers or other buildings thereon; and
- Upon any other security expressly directed by the rules of the society, not being personal security
- > No branch of a registered society needs to be separately registered
- A society, or any branch of Society, may (If the rules thereof so provide) hold, purchase, or take on lease any land, or build upon the same (with power to alter and pull down building and again rebuild).
